SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEY

We would like to thank our students, parents, staff and school community for taking part in our school climate survey last May. By providing us with information that is important to you, particularly in the areas of school safety, inclusive education and mental-health and well-being, you effectively helped guide school planning. Together, you identified what we do well, where we could improve and what your priorities are. Here is how your feedback is making a difference.

The survey questions that we asked:

1. What are your thoughts on your school meeting the educational needs of all of its students?
2. What are your thoughts on your school's safety?
3. What are your thoughts on how student mental health and well-being is supported in your school?

Top feedback 'themes' that we heard are important to you:

- Safety and Supervision
- Mental Health and Well-Being
- Teaching and Learning

Actions taken as a result of your survey feedback:

- Adding an official crosswalk and crossing guard at the front of the school for student safety.
- Looking at providing information to students, staff and parents about 'Cyber Safety'.
- Developing appropriate strategies for students to handle confrontations (Conflict resolution) in the school yard and on the bus.
- Providing information and promoting the development of a 'Growth Mindset' in children.
- Looking at childhood stressors and strategies for dealing with stress and involving board supports as needed.
- Creating an atmosphere that celebrates student writing.
- A focus on developing more hands on activities for students.
- A school wide focus on Number Sense and Multiplication understanding.
