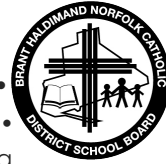

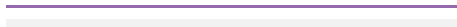
At the current time, we will also not have volunteers within the school until further notice. We appreciate your willingness to volunteer and will advise when this changes.
